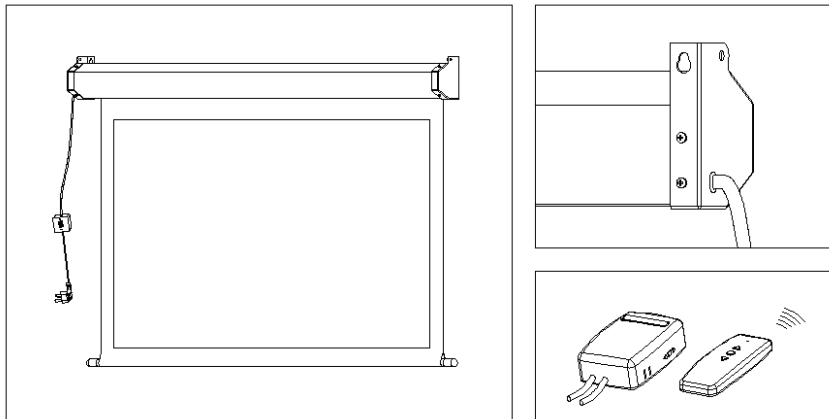

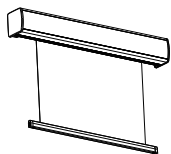

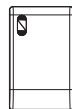

Matters Needing Attention

● Important Note

Warning Please observe the following instructions, as incorrect installation and improper use may lead to mechanical failure or personal injury.

Installation Notes

1. Please handle with care to avoid damage.
2. Do not use in a wet environment.
3. Keep away from fire/heat.
4. Do not attempt to service or modify this unit without professional assistance.
5. Make sure the voltage is consistent. Incorrect connection of wires may result in leaks or fires.
6. To avoid damaging the screen, do not fold the screen or touch the screen directly with your hands, tools, or any other abrasive/sharp object.
7. When not in use, retract the screen to protect the optical surface.
8. Do not run the screen continuously as the motor has an anti-overheating function and will shut down.
9. Keep the screen horizontally.



When installing or repairing please use a professional.



Please do not take off the head-caps to avoid electric shock.

Please do not adjust the limit by yourself.

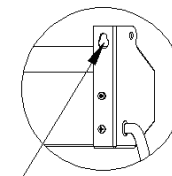
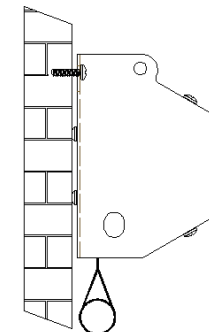
Cleaning

Do not use detergents or harsh chemicals to clean screen material. A soft cloth and mild soap can clean dust and dirt off the screen material. A cotton cloth can be used to gently wipe dust off of the screen.

Wall Mount Installation

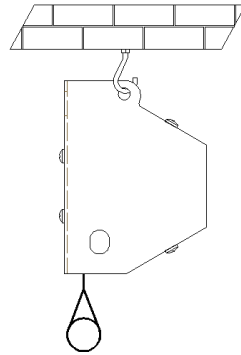
According to LA, mark the 2 holes on the wall and drill 2 holes(40-60mm deep), please guarantee that 2 holes are on the same horizontal line.

Hang the screen onto the screws. Tighten the M5 screws, then installation completed.

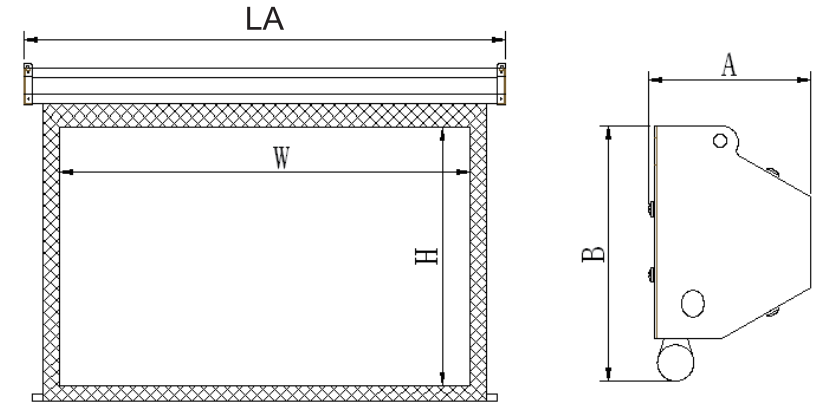


Ceiling Mount Installation

Hang the projection screen on the hook, and check the safety of the hook, and take reasonable measures to ensure the projection screen will not fall off under any circumstances.

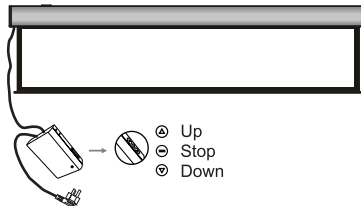
Usage

How to Use

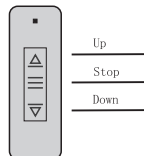
Manual control and remote control are optional for motorized screens.

I. Manual Control:

Use the manual switch to control the screen up and down.



II. Built-in RF Remote Control / External RF Remote Control / IR Remote Control are optional for motorized screens.



1. Press the "Down" button and the projection surface will lower itself. When it is fully extended it will stop automatically.
2. Press the "Up" button and the projection surface will retract into its case. When it is fully retracted it will stop automatically.
3. Press the "Stop" button to stop manually at an intermediate position.
